Nonfarm employment fully recovered pandemic losses, adding 37,200 jobs month-over

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Los Angeles County was unchanged over the month at 4.9 percent in November 2022, from a revised 4.9 percent in October 2022, and was below the rate of 6.9 percent one year ago. Civilian employment decreased by 21,000 to 4,713,000 in November 2022, while unemployment increased by 1,000 to 243,000. The civilian labor force decreased by 20,000 over the month to 4,956,000 in November 2022. (All of the above figures are seasonally adjusted.) The unadjusted unemployment rate for the county was 4.5 percent in November 2022.

The California seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.1 percent in November 2022, 4.0 percent in October 2022, and 5.8 percent a year ago in November 2021. The comparable estimates for the nation were 3.7 percent in November 2022, 3.7 percent in October 2022, and 4.2 percent a year ago.

Between October 2022 and November 2022, total nonfarm employment in Los Angeles County increased by 37,200 to 4,644,300.

- Total nonfarm employment added 37,200 jobs and reached its highest point since December 2019. At 810,100 jobs, this month marks the first time nonfarm job levels surpassed pre-pandemic levels. All 785,100 jobs lost between February and April of 2020 plus an additional 25,000 have been recovered since April 2020.
- Trade, transportation, and utilities (up 11,500) led the month-over growth. Typical holiday hiring in retail trade (up 8,700) accounted for most of industry sector gains. Transportation, warehousing, and utilities (up 2,600), helped drive up the growth with job development centered on couriers and messengers (up 3,500) which includes inter-city delivery of parcels and documents.
- Government services posted an increase of 7,900 jobs. Local government (up 7,300) accounted for 92 percent of the increase which was driven up by gains in local government educational services (up 6,600). Other industry sectors that reported monthly advances that exceeded 7,000 jobs include professional and business services (up 7,800) and information (up 7,500).
- Two sectors contracted over the month: construction (down 900) and other services (down 300). Mining and logging remained unchanged.

Between November 2021 and November 2022, Los Angeles County nonfarm employment increased by 193,800, or 4.4 percent.

- Educational and health services reported the largest year-over job advance with an addition of 43,000 jobs. Seventy-eight percent of the gains were centered on health care and social assistance (up 33,400). Social assistance (up 20,800), which includes services to children, youth, the elderly and disabled, accounted for the majority of the job advance. Private educational services (up 9,600) accounted for the remaining growth.
- Employment in leisure and hospitality was up 40,300 jobs. The payroll additions were largest in accommodation and food services (up 27,900), specifically in food services and drinking places (up 23,700). Increased activity in arts, entertainment, and recreation (up 12,400) also drew employment gains.
- Employment in professional and business services increased by 30,600 jobs. More than half of the gains were in professional, scientific, and technical services (up 16,100). Administrative and support and waste services (up 12,700), which is made up of companies that provide routine day-to-day support services to other organizations also helped drive up the industry growth.
- Every remaining industry sector reported year-over job gains including trade, transportation, and utilities (up 18,600), other services (up 15,800), information (up 11,100), manufacturing (up 10,800), government (up 10,000), financial activities (up 7,100), and construction (up 6,500). Mining and logging remained unchanged over the year.
